#### **Ukraine's State Security Directorate**

This coin celebrates Ukraine's State Security Directorate, a special-purpose state law enforcement agency, which plays a special role in safeguarding national security in Ukraine.

Obverse: to the left, against a smooth background, is the emblem of Ukraine's State Security Directorate; above the emblem are the coin's face value 5 and the graphic symbol of the hryvnia; under the emblem are Ukraine's small coat of arms, the legend YKPAÏHA / 2024 (Ukraine / 2024), and the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works; to the right, against a matt background, is the directorate's motto:

ДЕРЖАВІ. НАРОДОВІ. ЗАКОНУ (ТО THE STATE. TO THE PEOPLE. TO THE LAW).

Reverse: against a smooth background is a stylized composition that stands for different historical periods in Ukraine and the defense of the state by Ukrainian soldiers, whose courage has remained unchanged through generations. To the left is a stylized trident; in the center is a mace with sabers and a shield decorated with a Cossack cross, which represent power, combat brotherhood and protection; to the right is a fragment of a camera lens that symbolizes modern technologies in safeguarding safety and security.

Commemorative coins celebrate the mysterious symphony of emotions that blooms in people's hearts, the amazing feeling that has inspired poets, artists, musicians, and dreamers for centuries.

The obverse of the silver coin: against a smooth background, is a stylized rose made to look like a heart (decorative element – local gilding); the rose has the word "love" inscribed in it in the most common languages of the world, emphasizing the universality and boundlessness of this feeling, which has no borders and language barriers; above the rose are Ukraine's small coat of arms, the legend YKPAÏHA (with the dots above the letter "Ï" made to look like a heart), the coin's face value 10, and the graphic symbol of the hryvnia  $\frac{2}{3}$ ; beneath is the legend 20 / 24.

Obverse of the nickel silver coin: it repeats the general stylized composition of the obverse of the silver coin – against a smooth background, is a stylized rose made to look like a heart; the rose has the word "love" inscribed in it in the most common languages of the world; above the rose are Ukraine's small coat of arms, the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine) (with the dots above the Ukrainian letter "Ï" made to look like a heart), the coin's face value 5, and the graphic symbol of the hryvnia; above the stem of the rose is the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works; beneath is the legend 20 / 24.

Reverse: against a smooth background is a heart in relief, from which waves spread out evenly. The stylized composition symbolizes sincere and all-encompassing love, the vibrations of which reach the innermost depths of the soul.

Decorative element – local gilding.

Commemorative coins celebrate the greatest happiness in the world – that of being a parent, the thrill of the first hug and unconditional love for one's baby.

Obverse of the silver coin: against a smooth background, in the center is a composition of parental hands gently holding a baby's legs, symbolizing trust, a feeling of protection and love that unites the family; above in the center is the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine), under which are Ukraine's small coat of arms, the face value 5 and the graphic symbol of the hryvnia ₹ (to the left of the hands); beneath, in the center is the coin's issue year − 2024 (the zero in the legend is made to look like a heart).

Obverse of the nickel silver coin: it repeats the general stylized composition of the obverse of the silver coin –

against a smooth background are parental hands gently holding a baby's legs; above in the center is the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine), under which are Ukraine's small coat of arms, the face value 5 and the graphic symbol of the hryvnia &; to the left of the hands is the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works; beneath, in the center is the coin's issue year 2024 (the zero in the legend is made to look like a heart).

Reverse: against a smooth background, is a baby that is peacefully sleeping on soft clouds among toys (decorative element – pad printing). The rattle, which shines like the moon against the night sky, creates a feeling of calm and comfort. It illuminates the child's path to the world of dreams and fantasies, giving them carefree dreams.

Decorative element – pad printing.

This coin celebrates the Ukrainian RK-360MC Neptune coastal missile system, which was a significant breakthrough for the domestic defense industry in the development and production of modern weapons. It not only defeated one of the largest ships of the russian Navy in the first months of the full-scale invasion, but also wrote itself into the history of Ukrainian defense forever. The sinking of the ship, the moskva missile cruiser, is yet another proof that Ukrainian "cotton" will always be accurate. ("Cotton" or "bavovna" in Ukrainian, is a word used informally or jokingly in Ukraine to refer to explosions caused by Ukrainian weapons strikes on Russian targets. It came into use due to the similarity between Russian word, khlopok, meaning "a small bang," and khlopok, meaning "cotton." Though pronounced differently in Russian, the two words are spelled the same, and "khlopok" is frequently mistranslated by automatic translation systems into "bavovna" in Ukrainian.)

Obverse: there is a stylized image of the moscow missile cruiser with a hole in the hull, sunk thanks to the skill of Ukrainian military by R-360 Neptune anti-ship missiles. The "invulnerable" flagship of the russian Black Sea Fleet is stylized as a children's paper ship. This especially contrasts with the myth of the ship's power based on its size and weapons. The ship's deckhouse depicts the outline of the kremlin tower with the broken teeth of the kremlin wall, symbolizing the collapse of russia's imperial ambitions. Above, to the left, against a smooth background are the coin's face value 5 and the graphic symbol of the hryvnia at there are also the coin's issue year (placed vertically), Ukraine's small coat of arms, and the vertical legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine); beneath, to the left, is the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse: There is a Neptune coastal mobile missile system at the moment of missile launch. This system is in service with the Ukrainian Navy, as indicated by the emblem in the upper left. Against a smooth background is the stylized trident of Neptune, the god of the seas, symbolizing the indomitable Ukrainian spirit that deftly pierces enemy targets. Above, to the right, is the legend NEPTUNE, which runs parallel with the missile.

This coin celebrates a rare bird that has become a symbol of the revival of life in the Chornobyl zone – the black stork.

The 30-kilometer exclusion zone and the zone of mandatory resettlement, which was designated the Chornobyl Radiation and Ecological Biosphere Reserve on 26 April 2016, is now a special kind of breeding reserve not only for common species of animals and plants, but also for endangered ones, including the black stork. Thanks to environmental protection in the Chornobyl zone, the number of the birds is growing. This indicates the restoration of the region's ecosystem, and that the reserve is becoming a center of biodiversity even in the face of radiation contamination.

Obverse: above is Ukraine's small coat of arms, under which is the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine); to the right of the coat of arms is the coin's face value 5 / ГРИВЕНЬ (5 / hryvnias); in the center is a symbolic wheel of life

that marks the rebirth of nature: a stylized international radioactive sign shrouded in leaves and surrounded by animals that are increasing their populations in the 30-kilometer exclusion zone, which has become a kind of breeding reserve for black storks, Przewalski's horses, lynxes, bisons, moose, and brown bears; there is a circular legend against a smooth background, reading: ЧОРНОБИЛЬСЬКИЙ РАДІАЦІЙНО-ЕКОЛОГІЧНИЙ БІОСФЕРНИЙ ЗАПОВІДНИК (Chornobyl Radiation and Ecological Biosphere Reserve) (to the left) CHORNOBYL RADIATION AND ECOLOGICAL BIOSPHERE RESERVE; below is the coin's issue year – 2024; above is the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse: against an outline of a landscape scene is a black stork (pad printed). Above, to the left is a legend against a smooth background: ЛЕЛЕКА / ЧОРНИЙ (black stork) / CICONIA NIGRA; above are black stork chicks in a nest.

This coin celebrates the unity of Ukraine and Europe, and our shared values and aspirations for a peaceful and prosperous future. The celebration of Europe Day in Ukraine indicates not only geographical proximity, but also the spiritual kinship, historical heritage and solidarity that unite Ukraine with the European family.

Obverse: in the center is the stylized trident, a symbol of Ukraine. To the left of the trident are the EU's official motto  $\in$  ZHICTb Y PI3HOMAHITTI (United in diversity) (semicircular, above), and the vertical legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine) (next to the trident). Beneath are the coin's face value 5, the graphic symbol of the hryvnia  $\stackrel{\textbf{2}}{\text{-}}$ , the coin's issue year - 2024 (placed vertically), and Ukraine's small coat of arms. To the right of the

trident is a floral ornament that stands for the country's prosperity and distinctive culture. There is also the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse: against a smooth background, are the abbreviations EU and UA, which intertwine, creating a visual symbol of the unity of Ukraine and Europe. The two letters "U" seem to be one, forming the image of a new life that sprouts under the auspices of the European Union. The legends ДЕНЬ / ЄВРОПИ / EUROPE / DAY are surrounded by 12 stars that resemble those on the EU flag, symbolizing the unity, integrity and harmony of the peoples of Europe.

These coins celebrate a unique ornament that is an integral part of the national identity of the Crimean Tatars. The Ornek is a living heritage that has been preserving its unique beauty and deep meaning for centuries and serving as a source of inspiration for artists. Each embroidered or painted pattern is a kind of message that crosses time and space, connects the past with the present, and passes on the people's heritage to future generations. In 2021, the Ornek was officially included in the UNESCO Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

Obverse of the silver coin: in the center of the composition is a Crimean Tatar embroiderer (nağışçi), a charming craftswoman leaning over an embroidery machine (kergef). Her hands, masterfully handling the needle, breathe life into the canvas, creating exquisite Ornek patterns on it. The ornament sprouts in different directions from the craftswoman, symbolizing the continuity of the tradition and its unceasing continuation by talented descendants. Above is the semicircular legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine), below which are the legends ÖRNEK / OPbHEK; in the center between the legends is Ukraine's small coat of arms; to the right of

the craftswoman are the coin's face value 10, the graphic symbol of the hryvnia  $\frac{2}{3}$ , and the coin's issue year -2024.

Obverse of the nickel silver coin: the general stylized composition is that of the obverse of the silver coin: a Crimean Tatar embroiderer leaning over an embroidery machine; above is the semicircular legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine), below which are the legends ÖRNEK / OPbHEK; in the center between the legends is Ukraine's small coat of arms; to the right of the craftswoman are the coin's face value 5, the graphic symbol of the hryvnia  $\frac{2}{5}$ , and the coin's issue year – 2024; beneath, to the right of the embroidery machine is the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse: against a smooth background is an Ornek ornament in relief, which stands for familial values. In the center of the ornament are interconnected elements that reflect the deep symbolism of family ties. This family consists of the signs of a man, a woman, and their common home. On both sides of the central vertical are symbols representing children. Together they create a full-fledged ornament that reflects family unity and harmony.

These coins celebrate a noble act – blood donation, which demonstrates the highest humanity of helping others. This coin is a tribute to blood donors, whose invaluable contributions save lives and keep the nation healthy. It symbolizes unity, especially in difficult times, when one dose of blood can be a life-saver for several people at once.

Obverse of the silver coin: there is a composition, in the center of which is a three-dimensional drop of blood surrounded by schematic figures of people shaking hands. This image is a testament to the noble common goal of saving lives. From each figure, to the center of the circle, stylized drops of blood move, symbolizing the personal contribution to blood donation by each person who cares. Above, in the center is Ukraine's small coat of arms; the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine) is under the composition; beneath, to the right of the figures are the coin's face value 10 and the graphic symbol of the hryvnia  $\frac{2}{3}$ ; beneath, to the left is the coin's issue year 20/24.

Obverse of the nickel silver coin: the general stylized composition is that of the obverse of the silver coin:

an image of a drop of blood surrounded by schematic human figures; above, in the center is Ukraine's small coat of arms; under the composition is the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine); beneath, to the right are the coin's face value 5 and the graphic symbol of the hryvnia  $\frac{2}{5}$ ; beneath, to the left of the figures is the coin's issue year 20/24; to the right, between the figures is the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse: against a smooth background, to the right, is the legend ЖИТТЯ (life), which is stylized as a blood transfusion system with a needle. This element symbolizes the process of supplying blood to the vessels shown at the bottom left. Vessels that are already filled with blood are marked in red, and those that still need blood are marked in blue. The stylized drop and the legend життя (life) harmoniously combine to form the name of the coin— "A Drop of Life." The texture of the matte background on which all these elements are placed symbolizes the great need for blood donations in times of war.

#### The Light of Goodness and Love (Olena Pchilka 1849 – 1930)

This coin celebrates Olena Pchilka, one of the most prominent figures in Ukrainian history and culture. Olha Petrivna Kosach (her real name) was a legendary poet, translator, scholar, folklorist, ethnographer, publisher, and an active public figure. Her life was full of tireless work for the benefit of the Ukrainian people: from collecting the treasures of Ukrainian folklore and raising a brilliant generation to fighting for the right of Ukrainians to speak and write in their native language. Pchilka's creative heritage is still relevant today, and her name is a symbol of a Ukrainian woman who combines high intellectual culture, patriotism, and boundless love for Ukraine.

Obverse: there is a stylized composition symbolizing Pchilka's pedagogical and educational activities. In the center of the composition are six flower pots stylized as elements of the Hadiach ornament. This is not just a detail, but a symbol of the writer's six children, who were brought up in the spirit of Ukrainian traditions. The pot arrangement resembles the battlement of a castle wall, emphasizing the unshakable "fortress

of Ukrainian identity" that has resisted hostile influences for centuries. To the right, between the stylized pots is the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works; the bottom of the coin features the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine), the coin's face value 2, the graphic symbol of the hryvnia & Ukraine's small coat of arms, and the coin's issue year 20 / 24.

Reverse: against a smooth background is a stylized portrait of Olena Pchilka. The image of the woman against the background, the outline of which resembles a crown, impresses with its deep, wise and determined gaze. It seems to pierce through time, reminding us of the eternal significance of Pchilka's works. To the left and right of the portrait are the legends ΟΛΕΗΑ ΠΥΙΛΚΑ (Olena Pchilka) and ΟΛΙΒΓΑ ΚΟCΑΥ (Olha Kosach), and below in a semicircle is the legend ΚΟΡΟΛΕΒΑ-ΜΑΤΛ (Queen Mother), as Lesia Ukrainka lovingly called her mother. The years of the poet's birth and death 1849 / 1930 complete the composition of the reverse.

This coin celebrates the Leleka-100 multi-purpose unmanned aerial vehicle. Developed by the Ukrainian company DeViRo, it is a reliable defender of the Ukrainian skies, performing key military intelligence tasks and providing effective support for defense operations. In 2021, by order of the Minister of Defense of Ukraine, the Leleka 100 UAV officially came into service. Since then, it has demonstrated impressive effectiveness in combat conditions, becoming an indispensable tool for aerial reconnaissance and artillery fire adjustment.

Obverse: there is a stylized image from the flight control monitor of the Leleka-100 drone, which shows detected enemy targets – tanks – on steppeland roads. In the center is the outline of the drone, which embodies technological progress and Ukraine's innovative potential. Beneath, to the left, against a smooth

background is Ukraine's small coat of arms; to the right are the coin's face value 5 and the graphic symbol of the hryvnia &; under the drone, in the center, are the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine), the coin's issue year 2024, and the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse: depicts the reconnaissance drone in flight. Above it is a stylized outline of a stork, symbolizing the peace and tranquility provided by the vigilance of the Leleka-100. The lower part of the composition shows a view of the earth's surface with a stylized depiction of the area under observation by the drone, representing strategic vision and planning. The stylized vertical and horizontal scales symbolize the drone's ability to determine target coordinates and adjust artillery fire. Beneath, to the left, parallel to the drone, is the legend ΛΕΛΕΚΑ-100 (Leleka-100).

This coin celebrates the selfless work of Ukraine's medical professionals, who save thousands of lives both in the rear and on the front line under enemy fire and to the sound of air raid sirens. This commemorative coin is a symbol of gratitude and respect for those who do not seek fame, but deserve the highest recognition. It reflects the indomitable spirit of Ukraine, where every medical worker is a superhero of our time!

Obverse: there is a stylized strip of bandage with blood on it in the form of an outline of the territory of Ukraine. It is an unhealed wound in the heart of every Ukrainian that constantly hurts and bleeds. Above, against a smooth background, is the legend YKPAÏHA

(Ukraine); to the right of the legend is Ukraine's small coat of arms. Under the bandage, to the right, are the coin's face value 5, the graphic symbol of the hryvnia &, and the coin's issue year 2024; beneath, to the left, is the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse: in the center there are intersecting strips of bandage. They seem to isolate the wound covered by the hand of a military medic, which appears to heal and soothe the pain. This symbolizes the dedication and professionalism of medical workers, who fight for people's lives in the most difficult circumstances.

These coins celebrate the unique technique of Pliontanism, which was invented by the genius contemporary artist Ivan Marchuk. His signature style, similar to lace made of the finest strokes, gives the paintings three-dimensionality, creating dynamic light effects through a play of shades. These commemorative coins pay tribute to the outstanding artist, whose talent and innovative approach to painting have been recognized worldwide. The coins embody the inexhaustible creative power and depth of the Ukrainian soul, which live in every intricacy of lines on the artist's canvases.

Obverse of the silver coin: in the center is a fragment of the painting "Awakening" created by Ivan Marchuk in 1992. The design motif is a circle that associatively resembles the sun, symbolizing the source of life, energy and development. Under the stylized circle is the vertical legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine); above, in the center is Ukraine's small coat of arms.

The obverse of the nickel silver coin repeats the general stylized composition of the obverse of the silver coin. To the right of the composition, against a matte background, are the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine), the coin's face value 5, the graphic symbol of the hryvnia &, the coin's issue year – 2024, Ukraine's small coat of arms, and the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse of both coins: there is a fragment of the painting "Awakening" – an image of a girl with a blue and yellow ribbon on her head. The girl stands against the backdrop of the blooming vastness of her native land, symbolizing the awakening of Ukraine.

Decorative elements – pad printing, patina.

This coin celebrates the system of political organization of the state, an important component of the democratic organization of any country, which is founded on the principles of popular representation, the separation of powers and the rule of law. The Verkhovna Rada is the sole legislative body of Ukraine. It creates the country's legislative framework, performs oversight of the executive branch, and sets strategic state development directions. At present, even under martial law, the Verkhovna Rada is working to improve the legislative framework, protect the state and its citizens, and to implement reforms, changing worldview principles in all areas of life, and ensuring Ukraine's progress towards European prosperity.

In the center of the obverse is Ukraine's small coat of arms. At the top, around the coat of arms are stylized silhouettes of Ukrainians of today, from different social, age and professional groups. This embodies the idea of the diversity of the Ukrainian people and emphasizes that every citizen, according to Article 3 of the Constitution of Ukraine, is the highest social value of

the country. Between the silhouettes are the following legends: ПРАВА, СВОБОДА, ДЕМОКРАТІЯ, ЛЮДИНА, ЗАХИСТ ВІТЧИЗНИ, НАРОД, ПАРЛАМЕНТАРИЗМ, РОЗВИТОК КРАЇНИ, ІНКЛЮЗИВНІСТЬ, РІВНІСТЬ, ЄВРОІНТЕГРАЦІЯ and ЗАКОН (rights, freedom, democracy, human being, defense of the homeland, people, parliamentary democracy, development of the country, inclusivity, equality, European integration and law), which stand for the fundamental principles of democracy. Below the coat of arms is an information board for displaying voting results in the session hall of the Verkhovna Rada, which is recognized by all Ukrainians; under the board are the legend УКРАЇНА (Ukraine) and the coin's issue year – 2024; to the left is the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works; to the right are the coin's face value and the graphic symbol of the hryvnia €.

The reverse of the coin features a stylized Ukrainian ornament in a circle. Against a smooth background, in the center, is the logotype of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine.

This coin is a symbol of Parajanov's defiance, creative freedom, and eternal search for truth, a filmmaker whose heritage lives on in every shot and in every scene...

Obverse: against a smooth background is a stylized image of a pomegranate in section and of pomegranate

seeds. This image is an allusion to the master's naked soul, in which there was a place for Ukraine, where he lived and worked for some time. Above the composition are the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine), the coin's face value 5, the graphic symbol of the hryvnia & and the coin's issue year – 2024. In the center of the pomegranate is Ukraine's small coat of arms.

This coin celebrates the outstanding achievements of Ukrainian athletes who have made Ukraine famous on the world stage – from the first legendary records to the triumphant victory of boxer Oleksandr Usyk, who became the undisputed world heavyweight champion in May 2024. By holding simultaneously four of the most prestigious belts in boxing, he demonstrated to the world the indomitable spirit, fortitude and the limitless possibilities of Ukrainians. This coin honors the feats of Ukrainian athletes and reminds us that even in the most difficult times Ukrainians are capable of great victories.

Obverse: against a smooth background is a traditional Crimean Tatar ornament that stands for the Crimean descent of Oleksandr Usyk. This pattern, which was carefully selected and used by Ukrainian designer Elvira Hasanova as one of the athlete's images in the face-off before his fight for the title of undisputed world champion, emphasizes the inextricable connection between Crimea and Ukraine. Above, to the right of the ornament are the coin's issue year – 2024 and Ukraine's small coat of arms. Beneath, to the right are the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine), the coin's face value 5, the graphic symbol of the hryvnia & and the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse: in the center is a stylized image of the athlete against the backdrop of the outline of the Motherland Monument – a symbol of the invincibility and strength of the Ukrainian people. Beneath, to the left of the boxer's outline is the legend 18.05./2024 (18 May 2024) (the day of the fight); on either side of the boxer's outline are the legends ΑΕCO/ΠΟΤΗ/ΙΜ and UNDISPUTED (the title awarded to the athlete).

This coin celebrates one of the twelve animals of the Chinese calendar. The snake is the sixth sign of the Chinese zodiac, symbolizing flexibility, intuition, and calmness. It embodies deep knowledge, prudence, adaptability, and survival in any environment.

Obverse: above is Ukraine's small coat of arms, to the right of which is the semicircular legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine); against a smooth background are the 12 symbols of the Chinese zodiac depicted around a circle; in the center of the circle is a stylized clock with a hand pointing to the snake – the symbol of 2025; above the hand is the legend 2025; beneath, to the left, is the semicircular legend 5 ГРИВЕНЬ (5 hryvnias); against a matt background are the symbols of each season, stylized to resemble a Ukrainian ornament: a snowflake (above), a flower (to the right), a berry

(beneath), and a leaf (to the left); the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works is to the right, above the symbol of the tiger.

Reverse: in the center is the 2025 symbol of the Chinese calendar – a mysterious snake, which also means danger for the enemy. The image is made to resemble a hexagon, which expresses dynamics and inner strength, and together with the image of an aggressive head, it stands for hostility and unpredictability for an attacker. The tail of the snake is intricately twisted, resembling a saber and symbolizing readiness for struggle. The snake is circled by stylized symbols of each season: snowflakes (above, to the right), flowers (beneath, to the right), fruit (beneath, to the left), and tree branches (above, to the left).

This coin celebrates the centenary of the first Ukrainian radio broadcaster, which has been operating continuously since 1924. Radio Ukraine is the oldest radio station in the country, an important strategic broadcaster and a platform for uniting Ukrainians. Over the last century, it has gained the trust of generations of listeners and has become a public institution that informs, entertains, educates and consolidates citizens both inside and outside the country.

Obverse: In the center of the composition is Ukraine's small coat of arms, framed with semicircles of the repeated phrase ГОВОРИТЬ КИЇВ (Kyiv speaking) on the right, emphasizing the historical and contemporary role of Kyiv as a communications center. This element also depicts a stylized fragment of the contact line and the propagation of radio waves over

the occupied territories, symbolizing the importance of Radio Ukraine in defending national identity and countering enemy propaganda. Above is the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine), to the left of which are the coin's face value 5 and the graphic symbol of the hryvnia (placed horizontally) and the coin's issue year – 2024 (placed vertically); under this composition is the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse: there is a stylized depiction of the propagation of radio waves, the source of which is the dot above the Ukrainian letter "i" in the Ukrainian word "радіо" (radio). This letter is depicted as a kind of mast, which symbolizes the identification of Radio Ukraine. This commemorative coin celebrates the Bucephalus BTR-4E, a new generation armored vehicle that demonstrates the robust capabilities of Ukrainian engineering. This all-wheel drive armored combat vehicle features a combination of a high level of protection, powerful weapons, and excellent mobility, making it indispensable to Ukraine's Armed Forces and National Guard. This coin symbolizes the importance and effectiveness of the Bucephalus BTR-4E in bolstering Ukraine's defense capabilities, and recognizes the achievements of Ukrainian engineers in creating modern military equipment.

Obverse: against a smooth background, is a stylized image of a rearing horse modeled from armored plates that have been riveted together. The image of the horse

makes an association with the legendary Bucephalus, the horse of Alexander the Great, symbolizing loyalty, unbridled will and fearlessness in the face of the enemy. To the right, against a matte background is Ukraine's small coat of arms, under which are the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine), the coin's face value 5, the graphic symbol of the hryvnia  $\frac{2}{5}$ , and the coin's issue year – 2024. Beneath, in the center, is the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse: depicts a modern BTR-4 Ukrainian armored personnel carrier, firing from the combat module with which these vehicles are equipped. These coins celebrate Kharakternyk Cossacks – the legendary warriors of the Zaporozhian Sich. These warriors, shrouded in mystical fame, were distinguished by their unsurpassed skill in combat and mastery of weapons, which aroused fear among their enemies and admiration among their allies. The historian Dmytro Yavornytskyi described them as knights whom "neither fire nor water, nor saber, nor an ordinary bullet, save for a silver one, could fell." Today, Ukrainian defenders, like their ancestors, are demonstrating exceptional bravery, resilience and loyalty to their homeland, continuing the glorious traditions of the Cossacks.

Obverse of the silver coin: in the center of a composition is a stylized image of a soldier who is carefully holding and protecting the small coat of arms of Ukraine – a symbol of freedom and independence. The composition symbolizes the eternal desire of the Ukrainian people to live in their own sovereign state. Against a matte background are enemy bullets bouncing off the soldier, failing to hit the "Ukrainian soul." Under

the coat of arms are the coin's face value 10, the graphic symbol of the hryvnia  $\frac{2}{3}$ , and the coin's issue year -2024.

The obverse of the nickel silver coin repeats the general stylized composition of the obverse of the silver coin: a soldier is protecting the small coat of arms of Ukraine against the backdrop of bullets that are bouncing off him. Under the coat of arms are the legend УКРАЇНА (Ukraine), the coin's face value 5, the graphic symbol of the hryvnia €, and the coin's issue year − 2024. To the left of the soldier is the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse: Against a smooth background is a stylized image of a Kharakternyk Cossack who is protecting a bird — a symbol of freedom that has been made to look like a trident. The composition reflects the connection between the ongoing war in Ukraine and the Ukrainian spirit of the Cossack era. Against a matte background are broken enemy sabers that are powerless in the face of undying love for one's native land and the desire for freedom.





This commemorative coin celebrates the Archangel Michael, one of the main archangels, who is known as the Commander of the Heavenly Host (commanderin-chief in Greek). The Archangel Michael is one of the most revered biblical characters among believers. He leads "the heavenly army of angels," and is the patron of soldiers who fight for just causes. Respect for the Archangel Michael has been maintained since the days of Kyiv Rus to the present day. He was a symbol of the heavenly protection of Kyiv Rus princes. Later on, this reverence was manifested not only in toponyms – in the names of church buildings, but also in heraldry – on the coats of arms of Kyiv, the Voivodeship of Kyiv, and the Province of Kyiv. Today, the image of the Archangel Michael is present in the badges of Ukrainian troops and continues to symbolize the fight against evil.

Obverse: above is Ukraine's small coat of arms, below which is the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine); in a circle, against the background of the MM-14 pattern (the 2014

camouflage pattern, also known by its unofficial names Pixel and Ukrainian Pixel), is a stylized wreath made of laurel leaves, which stands for glory and victory; at the bottom of the coin are its face value 10 and the graphic symbol of the hryvnia ; in the center, in an octagonal cartouche, against a smooth background, is the NBU logotype, below which is the following legend: НАЦІОНАЛЬНИЙ/ БАНК УКРАЇНИ/2024 (National/Bank of Ukraine/2024).

This roll celebrates the State Special Transport Service (the Transport Service), a military formation that ensures the stability of the country's transport system in peacetime and in special periods. The Transport Service, which is part of the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine, has been bravely holding the transportation front since the first days of russia's full-scale invasion. The task of Transport Service personnel is not only to ensure the smooth operation of transport in the rear, but also to demine de-occupied territories, build fortifications, protect critical infrastructure, and restore it. Their work brings our common victory closer!

This medal celebrates the 10th anniversary of the adoption of the Law of Ukraine On the National Anti-Corruption Bureau of Ukraine. The NABU is a central executive body with a special status. It was created to prevent, detect, stop, investigate and solve corruption cases that pose a threat to national security. Since its inception, this institution has uncovered numerous cases of bribery, embezzlement of state property and illicit enrichment among high-ranking officials. This medal symbolizes the NABU's achievements in its fight against grand corruption, as well as the contribution of this law enforcement agency to shaping the future of Ukraine as part of the European community.

Obverse: in the center, against a smooth background, is the logotype of the National Anti-Corruption Bureau of Ukraine, above which are Ukraine's small coat of arms and the legend YKPAÏHA (Ukraine); beneath are the medal's issue year - 2024

and the mint mark of the NBU's Banknote Printing and Minting Works.

Reverse: in the center is a stylized image of a sunflower blooming under the sun, the shape of which recalls the logotype of the institution. The unlit and wilted petals the barren and dry land act as an allegory of the harmful effects of darkness and drought on the development of sunflowers, just as corruption negatively affects the development of the state and society. It is the "fight of light against darkness (corruption)" that allows sunflowers to flourish and states to develop and prosper. The overall composition of the reverse forms a stylized prohibition sign; there is also the circular legend – the NABU's slogan – ЗНЕШКОДИТИ i ЗАПОБІГТИ (Eradicate and Prevent). In 2024, the NBU continued to make Archangel Michael bullion coins that were designed in 2020.

Bullion coins are a special group of modern coins designed to be bought by a wide range of investors, including private individuals. Such coins are legal tender and are also classified as investment metals.

Bullion coins are a convenient way to make savings that is used by people in many countries.

Volodymyr Vernadskyi (1863–1945) was a famous Ukrainian scientist, philosopher, natural scientist, and the founder of a range of new scientific fields (geochemistry, biogeochemistry and radiogeology). He was also one of the founders and the first president of the Ukrainian Academy of Sciences, which was established in 1918.

The back of the note features the Presidium of Ukraine's National Academy of Sciences, which is accompanied by the patriotic slogan: CABA YKPAÏH!! FEPORM CABA! (Glory to Ukraine! Glory to the Heroes!) in dark-brown ink.

The Presidium of Ukraine's National Academy of Sciences was built in the 1850s to a design by architect Alexander Beretti. In 1892, a third floor was added to the building. Its facade features rustication and an attic decorative element with a cast-iron grid. The building was transferred to the Academy of Sciences in 1918.

The modified banknote incorporates all of the design and security features of the 1,000-hryvnia banknote designed in 2019; the back of the note, to the right of the legend Одна тисяча гривень (1,000 hryvnias) also features the patriotic slogan СЛАВА УКРАЇНІ! The back of the note features the Kyiv Mohyla Academy, which is accompanied by the patriotic slogan: СЛАВА УКРАЇНІ! ГЕРОЯМ СЛАВА! (Glory to Ukraine! Glory to the Heroes!) in gray-brown ink.

The Kyiv-Mohyla Academy was the first higher education school in Ukraine, founded in 1632. It was the largest general education center of the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries, which trained teachers of Slavic and Greek Catholic academies, figures of spiritual education, and teachers of theological seminaries. Skovoroda was one of the most famous graduates of the Kyiv Mohyla Academy.

The modified banknote incorporates all of the design and security features of the 500-hryvnia banknote designed in 2015; the back of the note, to the right of the legend П'ятсот гривень (500 hryvnias) also features the patriotic slogan СЛАВА УКРАЇНІ! Mykhailo Hrushevsky (1866–1934) was one of the most prominent figures of the 20th century. He shaped Ukrainian history both as the author of the multi-volume History of Ukraine-Rus, and as a civic and political activist and chair of the Central Council.

The back of the note depicts the Central Council building, which is accompanied by the patriotic slogan: СЛАВА УКРАЇНІ! ГЕРОЯМ СЛАВА! (Glory to Ukraine! Glory to the Heroes!) in purple ink.

This building was constructed in 1911 on Volodymyrska Street in Kyiv to a design by the famous Kyiv architect Pavlo Alioshyn. It was in this building that the Central Council in 1917 adopted its universals, declaring the sovereignty of the Ukrainian state.

This symbolizes the heritage of national traditions and the specifics of the Transport Service. In the background, a bridge is schematically depicted, symbolizing Ukraine's transport infrastructure and the main activity of the Transport Service, which is the construction and restoration of critical and transport infrastructure.


