The National Bank of Ukraine and Kyiv School of Economics are inviting students and young researchers to participate in the research conference *Banking Sector and Monetary Policy: Future Prospects*, which will be held on **24 May 2024**.

We invite students and young researchers (under 35) who are interested in research in the micro- and macroeconomic aspects of the banking sector and monetary policy. The topics may include (but are not limited to):

- macroeconomic aspects of monetary policy in wartime and postwar recovery
- effective regulation of the banking sector and ensuring financial stability in wartime
- bank lending and post-war economic reconstruction
- other topics in economics and finance.

The deadline for submitting the papers is **1 May 2024**. By 10 May 2024, all applicants will be informed about the Selection Committee's decision.

Conference participants will receive the reviews of submitted papers.

The best papers will be recommended for publication in the journal [Visnyk of the National Bank of Ukraine](#). In the case of a positive peer review, the NBU will defray all the costs, including the editing, translation, and publication of the article. The authors of the best works, as well as their academic supervisors, will have the opportunity to attend the VIII Annual Research Conference of the Central Banks of Ukraine and Poland *Navigating the Changing Landscape: Central Banks in a New Normal*, which will be held on June 20-21, 2024 in Kyiv in a hybrid format

The working languages of the conference are Ukrainian and English (no translation). The language of the presentation will have no effect on the competition results.
