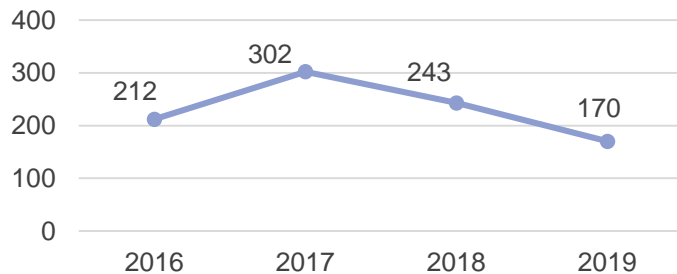
Goal – joining global expert society, increasing international visibility, establishing the NBU as a reliable partner

ITEC – exchange, sharing experience and expertise among the participants of international financial and banking community, including providing technical assistance to central banks of other countries

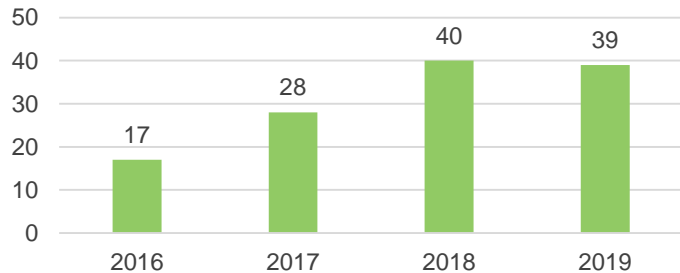

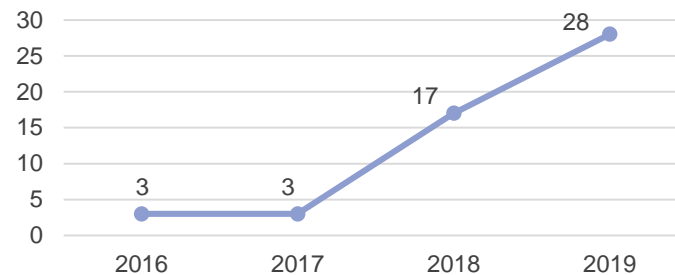

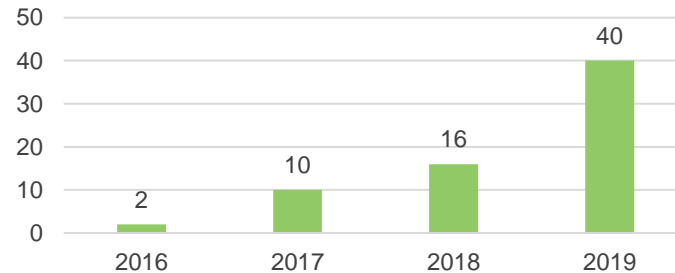

7 of them were big international events held by the NBU.

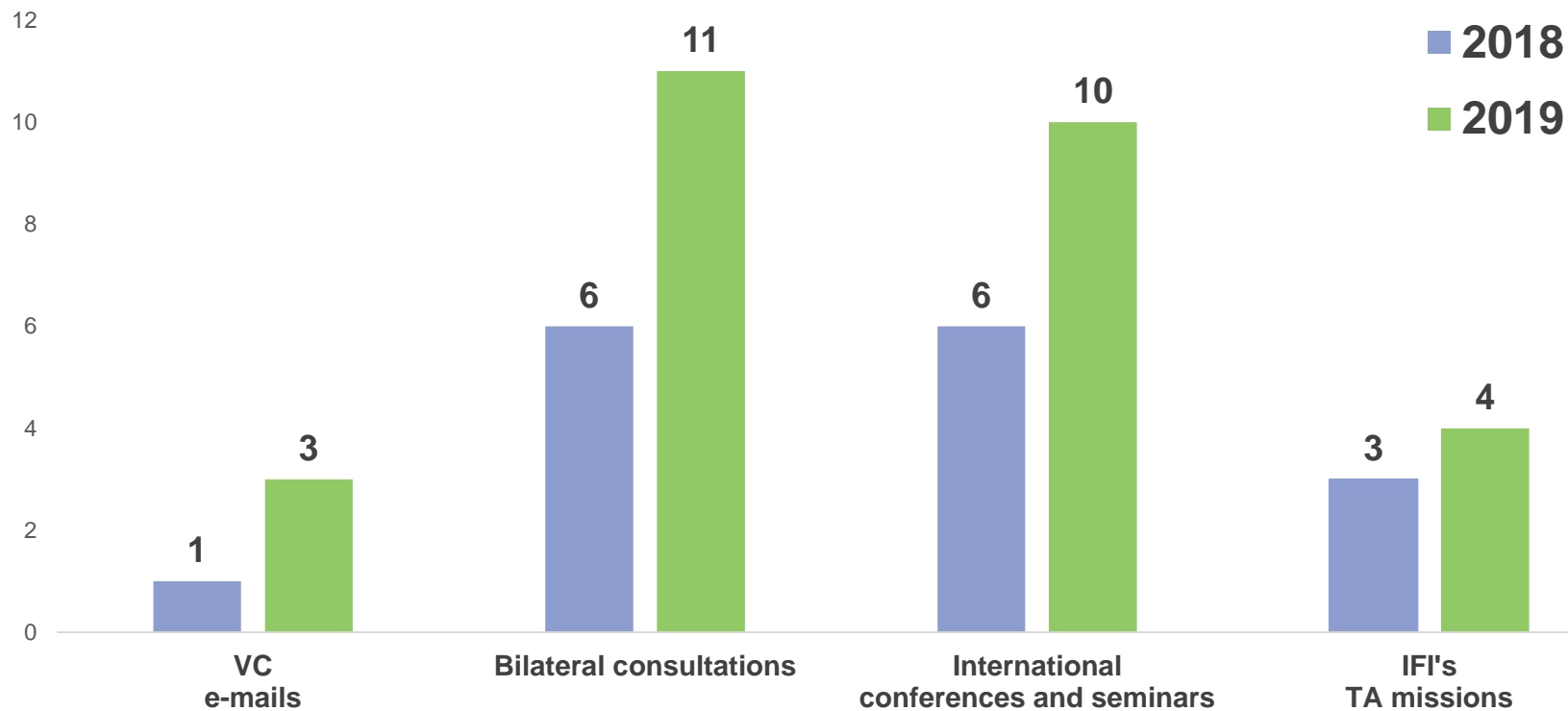
2019:

28 events, where the NBU experts shared their knowledge and provided experience to others.

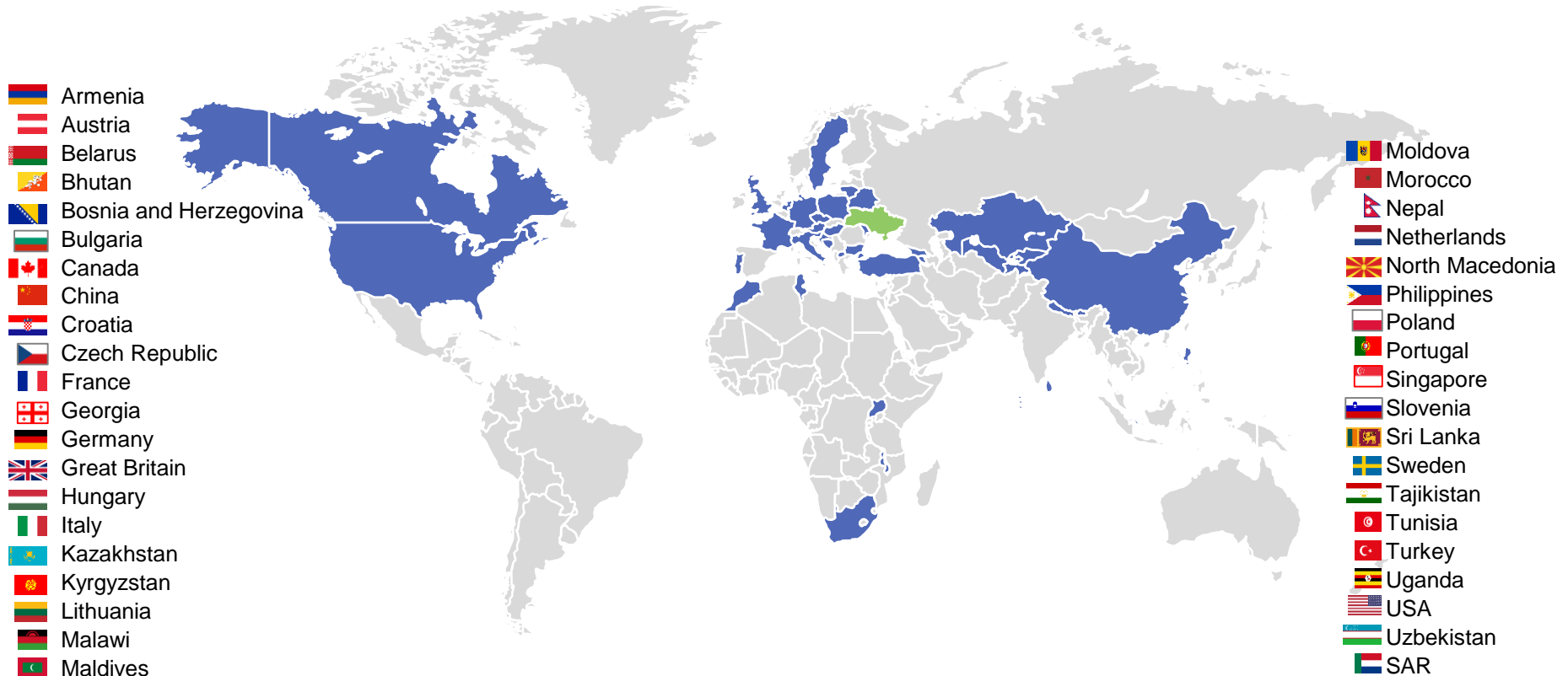
7 – big international events held by the NBU.
