In 2018, **35** money transfer systems provided services in Ukraine, whereof

28 were established by residents and 7 by nonresidents.







Operations of Money Transfer Systems in Ukraine Established by Nonresidents

As of 1 January 2019, **7** money transfer systems established by nonresidents operate in Ukraine: **3** US systems and **1** from Georgia, the UK, Canada and Azerbaijan each.

In 2018, the money transfer systems established by **nonresidents** to transacted:
