# Summary

## What is expected from visitors

### Who?

- prominent researchers with an established reputation in a field relevant to NBU priorities  
(from academia, research institutions, and other central banks)

### Duration

- various visiting schedules, e.g.:
- one research visit run for one to four weeks
  - few short-term visits (up to one week)

### Procedure


- Preferable option: By invitation based on proposal from NBU staff
- Applications are also considered

Visiting Scholar Programs, including participants, topics, and timing, are approved by NBU Board

- conducting NBU relevant research on a prespecified topic and disseminating the results publicly
- advising NBU research staff on their ongoing projects
- discussing policy issues with NBU top management

## What the NBU may to offer

- stimulating research environment in close proximity to the policymaking process
- reimbursement of travel and accommodation costs, per diem allowance
- other administrative support

## The purpose of Visiting Scholar Program

- ... to promote policy relevant research that meets high academic standards, allow prominent scholars to gain an insight into the policymaking environment of the NBU and enhance cooperation between visiting scholars and the NBU staff

### NBU expectations from Visiting Scholar:



- carrying out NBU relevant research, presenting research output at the internal and open seminars, and submitting the results to the NBU Working Paper series and journal “NBU Visnyk”
- joint projects with NBU staff are highly appreciated



- providing feedback on NBU staff research projects, participating in internal seminars, and acting as academic advisors to NBU staff




- participating in discussions with NBU top management on relevant policy issues

# Organizational issues

## Duration

- The program accommodates various visiting schedules, depending on the preferences of scholars and the needs of the NBU
  - One research visit run for one to four weeks
  - Few short-term visits (up to one week)

**Visiting Scholars may start at any time during the year, subject to agreement between each individual and the NBU**

**Visiting Scholar Programs, including participants, topics, and timing, are approved by NBU Board**

**Research Unit within Monetary Policy and Economic Analysis Department is in charge for program coordination from NBU side**

- prominent researcher (from academia, research institutions, and other central banks) with an established reputation in a field relevant to NBU priorities
- hold a PhD in economics, finance or econometrics
- fluent in spoken and written English (Proficiency in Ukrainian is not required)
- open for collaboration, strong communications skills

# Participating in the Visiting Scholar Program

## Preferable option: By invitation based on proposal from NBU staff

- research proposal (topic, motivation, methodology, expected results, etc.) and timing should be agreed in advance
- should be approved by NBU Board

## Applications are also considered: They should be submitted in English and must include

- a detailed curriculum vitae, including details of the publication record
- a concise research proposal that motivates and clearly describes the envisaged research project (max 1500 words)
- preferred timing of the visit(s)
