The National Anti-Corruption Bureau of Ukraine (NABU) is a newly formed state body, which was created after the Revolution of Dignity to meet public demand for fighting corruption in the highest echelons of power.

On 14 October 2014, the Ukrainian parliament adopted the Law of Ukraine *On the National Anti-Corruption Bureau of Ukraine*, and on 16 April 2015 the incumbent Ukrainian president signed a decree establishing the bureau. The institution has a special status and is engaged in the prevention, detection, termination, investigation and the solving of corruption cases involving senior officials, as well as the prevention of new crimes.

The NABU investigates cases involving top state officials, including MPs, government officials, judges and prosecutors.

Since it became operational, the National Anti-Corruption Bureau has initiated numerous criminal proceedings on cases of abuse by top corrupt officials, of which more than a thousand have already been brought to trial. The joint efforts of the NABU and the Specialized Anti-Corruption Prosecutor's Office, have recovered over UAH 9 billion for the state budget, and allocated more than UAH 2 billion to the needs of the Ukrainian defense forces.

The NABU's slogan is "Eradicate and Prevent". The body is designed to cleanse the government of corruption in order to create and develop a successful society and an effective state. The NABU upholds the values of justice and integrity, and works for the prosperity of Ukraine.
