

Ukrainian state symbols are a deep expression of historical continuity, national unity, and sovereignty. They encompass the fundamental attributes of statehood – the state coat-of-arms, the state flag, and the state anthem – which embody the will of the people and recall the glory of their ancestors. Their status as official symbols of national identity is enshrined in the Constitution of Ukraine.

The state coat-of-arms of Ukraine, the main element of which is the trident, dates back to the time of Prince Volodymyr the Great. Archaeological and chronicle sources attest to its use since the 10th century as the grand princely emblem. The image of the trident was minted on gold and silver coins – the zlatnyks and sriblianyks of Volodymyr the Great. In 1992, the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine approved the trident as the small coat-of-arms of Ukraine, designating it as the main element of the great coat-of-arms, which is to also include the coat-of-arms of the Zaporizhian Host.

The state flag of Ukraine consists of two horizontal stripes of blue and yellow. Its heraldic interpretation – from top to bottom – defines blue as a symbol of honor, loyalty, peace, the endless sky, security,

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and harmony, while yellow represents divine generosity, the Ukrainian wheat field, majesty, and respect. In the 20th century, the blue and yellow flag became a symbol of national awakening, especially during rallies and solemn events leading up to the declaration of independence. In 1992, the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine officially approved the national flag as a state symbol.

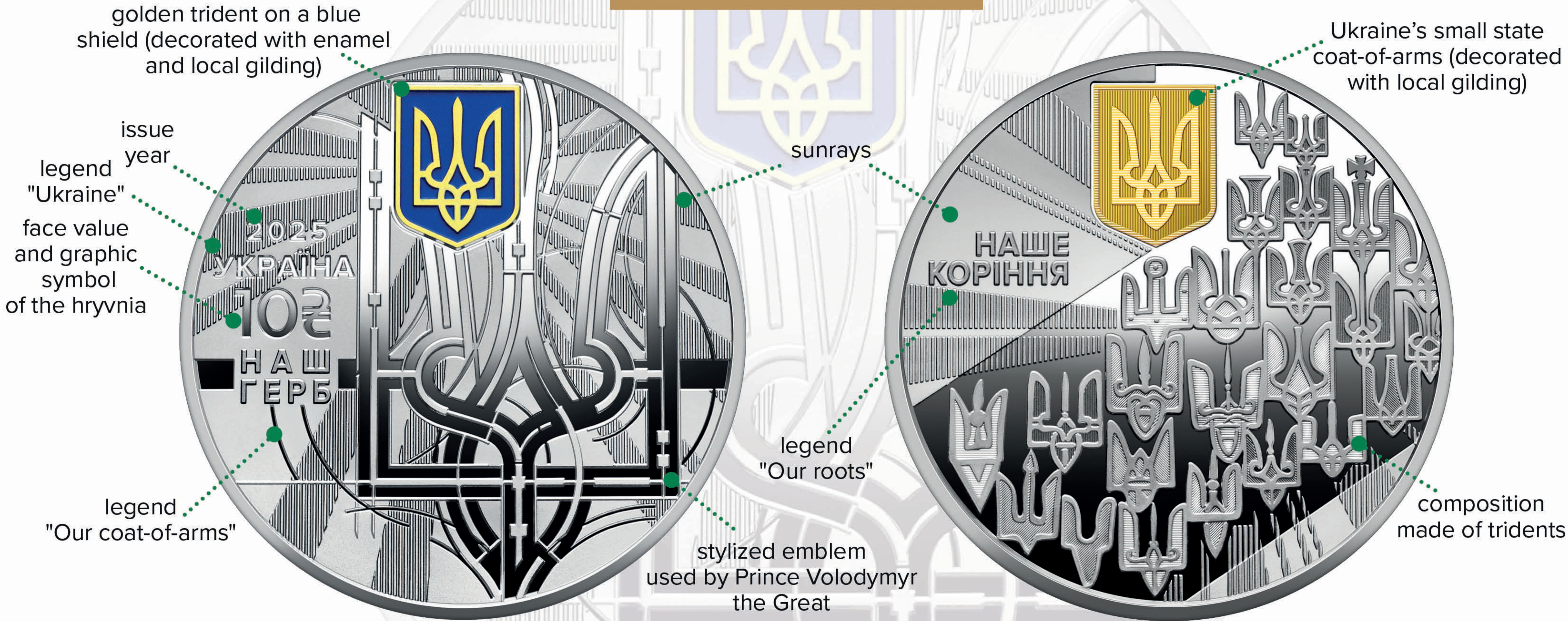
The state anthem of Ukraine is the musical and poetic embodiment of the national spirit. It is based on the first verse and chorus of the work "Ukraine has not yet perished" written by Pavlo Chubynskyi in 1862 and set to music by Mykhailo Verbytskyi. For a century and a half, this composition has been a symbol of unity for successive generations of Ukrainians. The anthem received official status in 1992, and its text was approved by law in 2003.

The state symbols of Ukraine are a code of national dignity and continuity. They unite generations, shape national memory, and remind us that freedom is a value we carry through time!

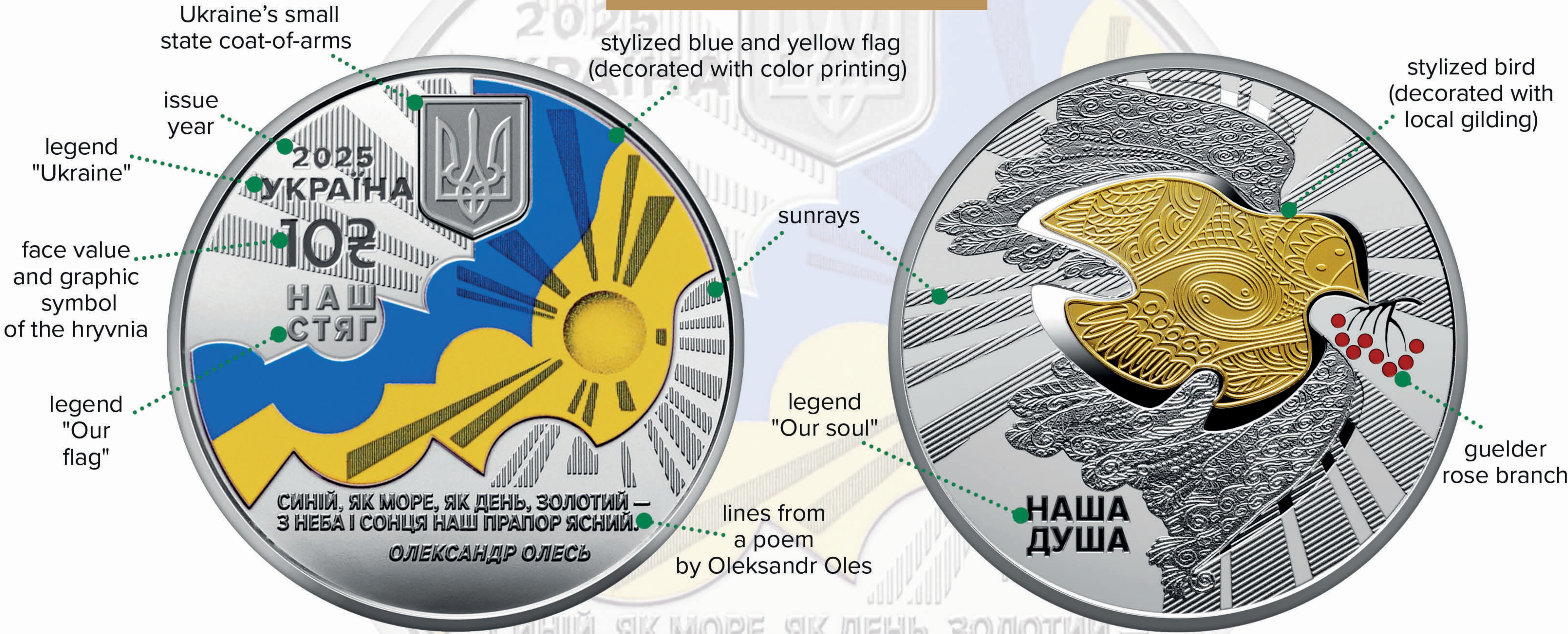

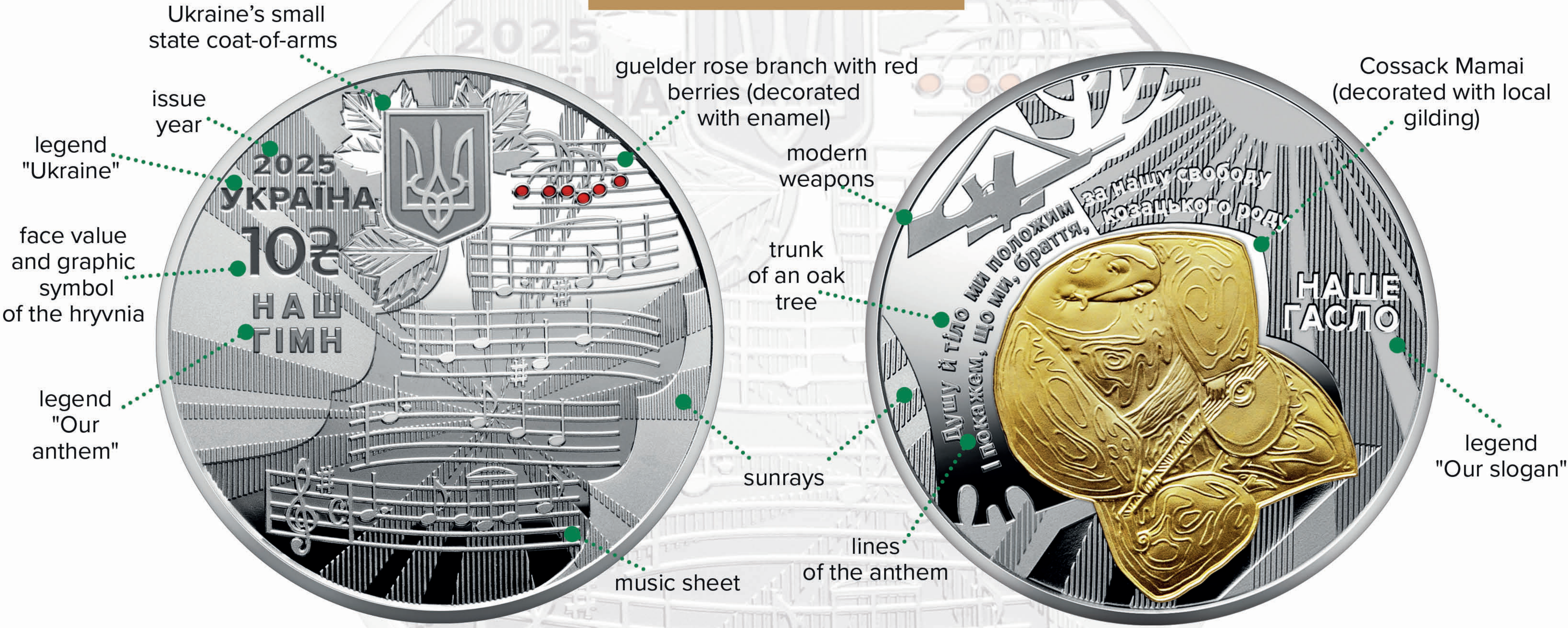
