The Leleka-100 unmanned aerial vehicle is a vigilant guardian of the Ukrainian skies, embodying advanced technologies and an innovative approach to reconnaissance technology. Developed by the Ukrainian company DeViRo, this drone has become a major tool in the hands of the Ukrainian Armed Forces for performing key military intelligence tasks, adjusting artillery fire, and providing effective support for defense equipment.

With a wingspan of almost two meters, this UAV can cover a distance of up to 100 kilometers, climb to an altitude of 1,500 meters, and fly continuously for up to two hours. The Leleka-100 can conduct reconnaissance both during daylight hours and at night. Its cruising speed is 60-70 km/h, and its top speed can reach 120 km/h. The multi-purpose UAV is also equipped with modules for optical magnification and a thermal imager for effective patrolling. These modules allow enemy positions, equipment, and personnel to be observed to the smallest detail. This vehicle is not vulnerable to enemy electronic warfare, as it is able to operate in radio silence mode. This guarantees the security of transmitted information and makes it impossible for it to expose the positions of Ukrainian troops.
